Hackney's Community Empowerment Network (CEN) is looking for someone with experience of developing and delivering projects which tackle youth crime issues in Hackney.

As a CEN rep, you will sit on Team Hackney's **Youth Crime Reduction Sub Group**, where decisions are made about policy and service delivery and some commissioning. Your role will be to raise issues from of voluntary and community sector (VCS) working to tackle youth crime and to feedback to the CEN about key decisions made at Team Hackney meetings.

If you haven't represented the VCS before don't be put off applying. The CEN needs people who have the local knowledge and skills to influence key decision makers in the Team Hackney Partnership. Through your community work you may have worked with the Police or Youth Offending Team for example and influenced them to change the way they work.

Once selected as a CEN rep, you will be supported by the CEN officer team and gain the opportunity to network with other CEN reps and contribute to wider consultations.

This is a voluntary role, although some expenses will be paid.
